

CILTHK Enduring Leader Experience Sharing Sessions 2022

To leverage on the success of last year's "Enduring Membership Award", a series of five webinars titled "**CILTHK Enduring Leaders Experience Sharing Sessions 2022**" has been arranged since July 2022. Five enduring leaders share their experiences and wisdom with CILTHK members and friends on the topics in their expertise...

Session 01: Transport Policy and its Influence to Our Future City, 21 July 2022

Dr Dorothy Chan, Honorary Chartered Fellow, has extensive experience in urban transport management and regulation. In view of the pandemic in the past two years which has deepened our concern on public transportation and whether new travel pattern would emerge with increasing acceptance on virtual meetings and working from home. Dr Chan shared her insights on the latest challenges faced by Hong Kong in maintaining urban mobility. Overseas experiences were quoted to highlight the inadequacies and future options. This webinar served as a guide tour to enable participants better understand from the local multi-modal transport system to the

recent and future challenges faced by Hong Kong. At the end of the webinar, Dr Chan addressed Congestion, Decarbonisation and Walkability in Hong Kong would be the key issues to examine in the coming future.

Session 02: Transportation in Hong Kong – Past, Present and Future, 4 August 2022

Mr Choi Sau-yuk, FCILT, is a seasoned professional and has led many assignments for government, public institutions and private companies in Hong Kong and elsewhere which cover port, airport and railway development and public transport projects, e.g. West Island Line, Chek Lap Kok Airport and the Third Runway System, Kai Tak Cruise Terminal, Western Harbour Crossing, Route 3, High





Speed Rail, Premium Taxis, and Bus Fare Adjustment Mechanism. He shared his 5-decades of experience associated with the transport sector, from his roles as a marketing person in liner shipping, in logistics management, to as a transport economist in port and airport planning. Mr Choi delivered the sharing session at CILTHK Office with live streaming on ZOOM platform.

From a small fishing port on the South China coast, Hong Kong has grown into one of the major transport hubs in the world, Mr Choi brought the participants tracking the development of shipping and aviation over the past years from an economics perspective, and examined the likely long term scenarios unfolding for Hong Kong, against the backdrop of the wider Greater Bay development and China as a whole continues its ascent to the topic of the new world economic order.

Session 03: Reinstating Railway Freight Service Between Hong Kong and The Mainland, 18 August 2022

The first cross-boundary freight train resumed arriving into Hong Kong on 2 March 2022. With this, an opportunity for restating a regular railway freight service by building a freight terminal with facilities like cargo integration, consolidation, and warehouses in the Northern Metropolis Development is raised. These facilities may reduce the pressure on land transport logistics and offer the logistics industry great work. Is it a rare opportunity that helps the Hong Kong Railway industry to become a

CILTHK Webinar: Service Excellence through Digitalisation | Interesting aspects about logistics digitisation in Hong Kong, 25 July 2022

As an extension of the Institute’s iconic event “CILT Award 2022 – Service Excellence through Digitalisation”, Mr Simon Wong, CEO of LSCM, was invited to discuss the development trend of digitalisation and its impact to the Industry in relation to the government planning and initiatives and the like to embrace digitalisation for the sustainable development of the Logistics and Transport Industry.

Mr Simon Wong pointed out that digitisation is no longer a “nice to have” option but an indispensable road that Hong Kong logistics industry need to take. “Smart Port”, POC (Proof of Concept) project undertaken by LSCM R&D Centre would be a part of the effort that Hong Kong Government is encouraging the industry to study and explore as an engine to achieve digitisation and further modernisation of Hong Kong Maritime Industry. Future warehouse, driven by robotics, automation and control system would be the key drive of logistics industry in the coming years. Mr Wong also showcased some key concepts with real-life examples and explained why System Integration is the key to successful digitisation in the webinar.






Luncheon Seminar: Introduction of Sydney Metro City & Southwest, 29 July 2022

Sydney Metro City & Southwest (SMCSW) project is part of the Sydney Metro and is Australia's biggest public transport project which will have 31 metro stations and more than 65 km of new metro rail. It is the extension of Sydney Metro Northwest (SMNW), which is the first fully automated operation metro (i.e. equipped with GoA4 signalling system) in Australia.

The webinar was delivered by Ms Candy Leung, CMILT. Candy is the Lead Engineer – Rolling Stock, Aurecon and working in Australia. In this seminar, Candy introduced Sydney Metro and its railway network. She illustrated the overview of SMCSW Project, included its project timeline, subcontract structure and train features. It's no doubt the COVID-19 has been bringing lots of challenges in every walks of life, Candy also shared the challenges faced in the Project such as labour shortage caused by the Pandemic.


Career Advancement and Life Formula (CALF)


